



WIJMA Guidance on Sealing of Placement Plans

Placement plans (sometimes referred to as layouts) are often provided by the EWP (engineered wood product) supplier to aid in the installation of engineered wood products, including structural composite lumber and prefabricated wood I-joists. The intent of a placement plan is to show product location and orientation to aid in the installation of the products listed.

Placement plans are not intended to replace construction design documents provided by the project's design professional of record. For projects where a design professional of record is involved, the placement plans should be reviewed and approved by the project's design professional of record.

For projects where a design professional of record is not involved, a seal on a placement plan should not be required. Sealing a placement plan may erroneously imply that the sealing design professional is the project's design professional of record.
